The Berlinale mourns the loss of Philip Seymour Hoffman

The Berlin International Film Festival mourns the actor Philip Seymour Hoffman.

In 2006 the Berlinale *Competition* presented *Capote*, the film directed by Bennett Miller which won Philip Seymour Hoffman a Golden Globe and later an Oscar as Best Actor.

This exceptional performer also appeared in Berlinale films like *Owning Mahowny* (*Panorama* 2003) and Spike Lee's 25th Hour (Competition 2003). He was unforgettable in the roles he played in two Berlinale films in 2000: Anthony Minghella's *The Talented Mr. Ripley* and Golden Bear winner *Magnolia* directed by Paul Thomas Anderson.
