In Focus: Diverse Documentary Forms and Events

The Berlin International Film Festival has long been committed to documentaries in their diverse forms. This is reflected in the programmes of the Berlinale's different sections and initiatives, as well as in the European Film Market (EFM) and Berlinale Talents.

In 2016, a total of 77 documentaries will be screening in a variety of forms. In addition, discussion of a wide range of different aspects related to documentaries will be intensified - at workshops, panels and presentations.

European Film Market (EFM) - "Meet the Docs"

The *EFM* documentary networking platform "Meet the Docs" will take place for the eighth time in 2016. The initiative, in collaboration with the European Documentary Network (EDN), promotes exchange among the international documentary industry, who can meet and mingle at the "Meet the Docs" stand in the Martin-Gropius-Bau. Accredited Festival and Market visitors can participate in the enhanced panel series programme and one-on-one meeting format "Meet the Festivals" with programmers of international documentary film festivals and benefit from a documentary film project consulting by EDN.
