Log Line: Frustrated at not being heard for the adult he thinks he is, 17-year-old Yasha's self-expression takes a disturbing turn.

Synopsis: Like any teenager, 17-year-old Yasha is rebelling against authority, but in 1990's Soviet Ukraine some of the opposing forces are more dangerous than others. When Yasha hits his breaking point, raw impulses propel him to the precipice of irreparable harm.

Writer/Director Gleb Osatinski, Director's Statement

OBRAZA (Resentment) is a story of my childhood where I, with my family, had to experience something hard to forget. In retrospect, it is about feeling bitter anger at being mistreated. It's about resentment. I wanted to tell the story of resentment and make a film that feels like a cautionary tale that echoes from one generation from the past to another in the future. I wrote this story of the past because I felt compelled and then, suddenly, the world caught up with it.

Resentment accumulates. It is a feeling that drips internally, one drop at a time, causing an overflow that can lead to an outburst of anger and violence. I wanted the audience to ask: what ignites the violence we experience today? What is it that no matter how much we know about the past, we are still provoked to pull the trigger? Maybe before the knowledge, there is something else? Is there a feeling that is simply shuttering our emotional comeback by making us react hatefully? I wanted to identify these avalanches within us before they are hard to stop.

We live in a world of wars and self-destruction, but we are all humans; we all feel, and if we recognize this bitter aftertaste that originates from within and lasts a long time, we may still be under its influence.

We must stop and think about what triggers us. If resentment lives within us, we all have the potential to destroy and be destroyed.

Bio Gleb Osatinski is a director and screenwriter. Gleb has directed and produced several award-winning short films, which have screened at more than a dozen film festivals around the world. He is a recipient of the 2020 Katherina Otto-Bernstein grant at Columbia University and Fiscal Sponsorship at Gotham (IFP) for his latest project **OBRAZA (Resentment)**. Gleb is a Lighthouse Selections Talent at T-Port Market in 2021 curated by Celine Roustan (Programmer, Palm Springs International Film Festival & ShortFest, SXSW, TIFF.) Gleb is a graduate of Columbia University School of Arts, 2022. Gleb lives in New York City with wife Katia, 7 years old daughter Eva, and a dog, Kit.

We remained committed to that mantra throughout, choosing to shoot on 16mm, as well as turning down investors who only wanted to "fix some things." We looked hard for, and connected with, other artists who shared our vision, like Smart Casual Productions, in Lithuania; Cinematographer Vytautas Katkus, and a talented cast of dedicated actors.

Bio & Filmography J Dixon Byrne, "Dixon", is a producer, actor, writer, and film advisor. He was Executive Producer for Lodge Kerrigan's breakthrough feature, *clean, shaven*. Additional production credits include, Executive Producer for Michael Perrone's award winning second feature, *The Man Behind the Camera*; Co-producer of *The Plagiarist*, by award winning writers, James N. Kienitz Wilkins and Robin Schavoir; and Executive Producer of *Otherland*, by Alex Brisker and Alexander Le Bas.

An award-winning SAG/AFTRA actor, Dixon was a member of The Villanova Theater Group and studied at HB Studios, in New York. He has performed in a variety of local and New York City stages, multiple TV commercials and has appeared in over thirty films. His work has appeared at Cannes, The Whitney Biennial in New York, The Tate Modern in London, and various festivals worldwide, and can be seen on Amazon Prime, Eternal Family TV, iTunes, Memory Channel, Mubi, The Criterion Channel, and Tubi.

As a writer, he published an experimental memoir, under the pseudonym James Patrick, titled, "There's a Person in Here", of which Kirkus Reviews remarked: "A moving account of the profound moments in one man's life." Dixon is also creator/writer for two online ventures. He created The Perception Tapes, which offers downloads of fictionalized "lost/rediscovered" audio tapes that challenge a listener's belief system; and Feature Film Treatments, where he offers a variety of feature film treatments for option or purchase.

Dixon is a colon and pancreatic cancer survivor, was married twice, divorced once, the father of four children, (three survive) and a grandfather three times. He also survived thirty years in the advertising industry. The recurring spirit/theme of all his work can best be described by his motto: "Don't let the bastards wear you down."

About the Production

And, while I know the time was right for Gleb to make this film, I believed the story to be timeless. To me, our film is a representation of the desire to be heard and valued that is in each of us, and the potential consequences of marginalization and rejection of that innate need. I hoped that addressing resentment head on, would, in some small way, challenge current thinking and behavior, and help more voices be heard.

Our production was far from a straightforward process and we faced budget, timing, crew, and casting setbacks because of international conflicts in Ukraine.

Few Words about production in Lithuania:

How and when the decision to film in Lithuania was made...

We tried to make the film in Ukraine, but with the start of the war it became impossible.

We had to rethink our approach and reset after the war drew inevitably closer.

With the war starting, we had to cancel our plans and restart pre-production a year later.

We had met Smart Casual through the cinematographer, Vitalius who was already working with Gleb for a few years.

About the location...

In Vilnius and in a small town near Vilnius called Elektrėnai. Although initially we had planned to shoot in Ukraine and had established a budget including over three months of pre-pro including location scouting by Gleb and casting in Kiev. But those plans collapsed with the approaching war in Ukraine. We had to rethink the whole strategy.

About shooting on film

We used Kodak Vision3 500T 16mm. We used Aaton XTR and Zeiss primes and zoom lens. We shot at a Super 16 mm ratio 1.85:1.

A Few Words about Casting ...

Gleb started working on casting in 2020 with Valeria Ruban Casting in Ukraine. During COVID a lot of casting was done via Zoom.

On Feb 22 Gleb traveled to Kyiv and held final casting there. After the casting was locked, he returned to New York and we locked the production dates. But with the start of the war, the plans to have production in April collapsed and we lost the cast. Male actors could not leave Ukraine due to the mobilization law in Ukraine. We tried a year to bring them when we realized that it was not possible.

Through Smart Casual, Gleb started a new casting process. He was introduced to the Casting Director, Andrius Blazeivicius. Gleb found our lead Vlad Baluik via instagram. It was almost like magic because we started to lose hope to find actors for our film. There were very few actors from Ukraine in Europe, it was a very hard and stressful moment. Olesya Ostrovskaya and Vlad Volk came from the first group of actors because Vlad Volk was in Dublin and Olesya could travel from Kyiv. Andrius found Sergey Zdoronkov who lived in Vilnius. Sergey is actually from Belarus, but he lives in Vilnius. Andrius helped with other actors and he found Ariana Rimkute, Ludmila Gnatenko and Martinaitis Vaidotas.

We also were fortunate to find a few actors as extras from Ukraine who temporarily lived in Vilnius and we were happy to have them on our set. The Final cast was locked in Vilnius about a month before the production started. Gleb came to Vilnius two months prior to the production and stayed there until the production was finished. We received dailies only a couple of weeks after the production was over when the footage was scanned.

Labs, Mentors, Advisors ...

OBRAZA is Gleb's thesis film for his MFA degree at Columbia University MFA program. Through the University Gleb has received a prestigious Katharina Otto-Bernstein grant and her mentorship for his script. At Columbia University Gleb has been also workshopping the story in his thesis class taught by his advisor professor, Bette Gordon.

Post ...

First, we did the 1k scan with Focus Film in Stockholm, Sweden. The company was introduced to us by our Smart Casual team. Then, most of our post was done in New York City.

The 1k scan was edited in New York City by Gleb in Columbia University labs. When edit was locked, we did the 4k scan. With Focus Film. Special effects were done in New York City as well. Gleb worked with his friend , Alex Shum, who Gleb worked with in the past.

Post production sound design by Greg Smith, a sound designer Gleb knew for many years. They have been working together on multiple Gleb's films before.

Grading was done in Vilnius. After the edit was locked, we sent it back to Vytautas Katkus and his colorist in Vilnius Justinas Vencius.

DCP was done in Columbia University labs with help of Gleb's professor and post production supervisor at Columbia Michael Cacioppo Belantara.

Vladyslav Baliuk (Yasha) Vladyslav Balyuk is a young Ukrainian actor known for his performances in such films as «Felix and me» (the role of Timophiy, directed by Iryna Tsylyk), «Don Zhuan from Zhashkov» (the role of Kostya, directed by Viktor Butok) and «Obraza» (the role of Yasha, directed by Gleb Osatinski). Vladyslav has experience of performing in various student short films as well. Also, Vladyslav played in a theater in Ukraine as an actor and began his professional studies in Kyiv in 2021 studying theater acting. At the present Vladyslav is based in London.

Sergey Zdoronkov (Saul) Sergey Zdoronkov - theater and film actor, theater director, writer. Born on November 17, 1982, in the beautiful Latvian city of Liepaja. Starting from the 2nd grade, he studied in the school theater in Latvia, after graduating from school he entered the Belarusian State University of Culture and Arts, Minsk, Belarus, as a theater director, graduating in 2007. He worked as an actor and director in several theaters in Belarus (before the events in Belarus in 2020). In 2003, he began working as an actor in films. He starred in Belarusian (before the events in Belarus in 2020, in Ukrainian, Kaakh, Uzbek, Russian (before the Russian aggression against Ukraine) films. After moving to Lithuania, he starred in films in the USA-Lithuania, Finland, Austro-Germany. I also write fairy tales for children and adults. Starred in such films as: "Deep Current", "Relay Race", "Taste of Revenge", "In the constellation Sagittarius", "Smersh", "The Last Armored Train", "Investigator Protasov", etc. feet of others. One of the most significant works in recent times, the film "Obraza" (USA-Lithuania) directed by Gleb Osetinsky

Liudmila Gnatenko (Anna) Born in Vilnius on 1973.05.03. 1991-1995 studied at the Lithuanian Academy of Music, faculty of theater and film actress. In 1995 she began working at the Vilnius Old Theater

Ariana Rimkutė (Vera) Ariana was born in 2013 in Lithuania. Since her dad is from Lithuania and her mother is from Belarus, he lived in Belarus for the next seven years. At the age of four she began training at the "Menada" dance studio. Later, at the age of six, she was casted to study at the Dolce Vita international modeling school. She started taking vocal lessons at the age of seven. For eight years, she moved with her parents to live and study to Lithuania. The studio of stars began training at the Vilnius Center for Musical Development. As a member of the vocal ensemble "Flowers", she took part in the 10th anniversary international forum of arts "Eurojurmala 2022". Since nine years she is studing vocal and piano at the Lithuanian public music school "Lyra". At the same age she began studying at the Belarusian theater school in Vilnius. 2023 passed the casting for the film Resentment directed by Gleb Osatinski.

Vaidotas Martinaitis (Ivan). Born in 1968 in Gargždai, lives in Vilnius. In 1983-1988, he studied at Klaipėda's S. Šimkaus Higher Music School (trumpet specialization); In 1988-1990 he studied at the Lithuanian State Conservatory (trumpet specialization); 1990-1994 studied at the Lithuanian Academy of Music, Faculty of Theater and Cinema, Department of Acting Mastery (specialty actor). The course leader is Jonas Vaitkus. From 1991-2011 – Lithuanian National Drama Theater actor. Since 1999 - Member of the theater troupe of Oskar Korshunov. Since 2012, he has been cooperating with the Kaunas State Musical Theatre. Since 2012, he has been working as an acting teacher at the M. K. Čiurlionis Art School. In 2012-2014, he conducted acting mastery seminars in the sports dance group "Ratuto".

Alina Cheban (Lilya)

Vladyslav Volk (Bycha) Vlad Volk is a Ukrainian actor. Vlad was born in Odesa, Ukraine where he started doing his first steps in acting. He made his film debut at "My mermaid, my lorelyay" and his stage debut with "Family scenes" production in Odesa V. Vasilko Academic Music and Drama Theatre. Vlad pursued his passion for acting at Kyiv National I. K. Karpenko-Kary Theatre and Cinema University, which gave him lots of professional experience and joy. Due to the Russian full-scale invasion of Ukraine, Vlad is currently based in Dublin, Ireland. He continued his studies at Mozarteum University Salzburg and Bow Street Academy, where he improved his English skills and got lots of screen acting experience. He recently starred in Gleb Osatinski's film "Resentment", the world premiere of which will take place at 74th Berlinale film Festival, and in the performance "DerRosenkavalier" on the stage of one of the best Irish theatres - Bord Gais Energy Theatre."

Olesia Ostrovskaja (Darya) Lesya Ostrovska is a Ukrainian theater and film actress. She graduated from the Kyiv University of Theater, Film and Television named after I.K. Karpenka-Karogo (Y.M. Mazhuga's workshop). She has more than 50 projects in movies and TVshows, including four international projects and two films - winners of film festivals. Also, Lesya is a Coach of acting skills.

Cinematographer Vytautas Katkus is cinematographer from Vilnius, Lithuania. In 2019, Vitautas presented Community Gardens at the 58th edition of La Semaine de la Critique, a languid summer tale of a father-son relationship where apparent gentleness conceals a burning fire.
