Director Dominik Moll will be president of the „Dialogue en Perspective“-Jury of TV5 Monde and the German-French Youth Office

The German-French director Dominik Moll will be the president of the jury for the prize “Dialogue en Perspective” at the 56th Berlin International Film Festival. For the third time TV5 Monde is official partner of the Berlin International Film Festival and will be presenting the prize together with the German-French Youth Office (DFJW). Seven film fans between 18 and 29 years old will make up the jury that chooses a film from the Berlinale section *Perspektive Deutsches Kino*.

With Dominik Moll as jury president – after Albert Wiederspiel, director of the Filmfest Hamburg and film director Nina Grosse – once again a personality has been won over who stands for the intercultural cinematic dialogue between Germany and France. His film *Harry, He's Here to Help* was a success with audiences in France and Germany alike. The 43-year-old director is looking forward to deciding the winner of the prize “Dialogue en Perspective” 2006 together with the German and French jury members: “I was immediately enthused about the idea to head the jury of the prize “Dialogue en Perspective” because the cinematic dialogue between both countries and the interest for the films of our neighbours is something very close to me. I am eager to see how the German-French jury will react to the films and am already looking forward to a lively discussion that will surely be inspiring for my own work”.

Dominik Moll was born in 1962 in Brühl, Germany as the son of a French mother and German father and grew up in Baden-Baden. He studied film in Paris and New York and already shot six short films during his studies. His first film *Intimité* was acclaimed by critics and *Harry, He's Here to Help* was celebrated by audiences. His new film *Lemming* was shown at the Cannes film festival 2005. Currently Moll is working on a new screenplay.
