The Summer Berlinale Presents Gripping Cinema in Berlin, Cologne and Nuremberg

From June 30 to July 3, movie fans in Berlin will have the opportunity of spending warm summer evenings watching outstanding films selected from this year's Berlinale programme. During the 9th Summer Berlinale, the radioeins Open-Air Cinema Friedrichshain will show film highlights that have not yet been released theatrically in Germany.

In addition to this year's Golden Bear winner *Nader And Simin, A Separation*, the programme includes audience favourites from the *Panorama, Generation* and *Perspektive Deutsches Kino* sections. Section directors Wieland Speck, Maryanne Redpath, Florian Weghorn and Linda Söffker will introduce the films.
