## The Berlin International Film Festival Mourns the Loss of Nagisa Oshima

Prizewinning Japanese director Nagisa Oshima died on Tuesday, at the age of 80. In 1976, he caused a scandal at the Berlinale with his film *Ai no corrida* (*In the Realm of the Senses*), which was confiscated on the suspicion of being pornography. As a Japanese Nouvelle Vague filmmaker, Oshima's works contained much sex and violence, and so often bordered on provocation.

Considered a significant part of the Festival's history, his "scandalous" film was re-screened on occasion of the Berlinale's anniversaries in 1990 and 2010. Another Oshima classic was also shown in 2010, in the Berlinale Special programme: the post-war drama *Gishiki* (*The Ceremony*, 1971).
